Greetings Kristiné and James. Thank you again for taking the time to meet and have dinner last night. Looking forward to seeing you both in Monterey.

Attached is the Draft JLUS Implementation Matrix the NBK JLUS consultant has prepared, which they will be discussing with stakeholders at today's joint policy and technical committee meeting. This is the very first draft for internal committee review. For each recommendation, the matrix includes implementing party, timeline, priority, rough planning level cost estimates, and potential funding sources. It is based on partner, stakeholder, and community outreach thus far plus and analysis of the relevant planning issues. The goal will be to discuss these items and make necessary adjustments that will go out to the public in the Draft JLUS report on February 12.

Note the item associated with the WMA under the Regional Planning and Coordination Section, which reads "Coordinate with the WMA on statewide military planning strategies; incl. the recent OEA grant related to military reductions." This signals to me that they are looking at some statewide measures to address compatible use. I will ask them to modify a bit to read something like this "Coordinate with the WMA on statewide military planning strategies; incl. the recent OEA grant related to potential defense spending reductions."
